Marty called the meeting to order at 6:06 p.m.

The board began with reviewing the proposed changes to the Lakes District.

The board expressed concern with the removal of grandfathered status of existing cottages as things are written in the proposed changes.

Permitted uses:

#6 Group homes have been removed - board is okay with this

#8 Upgrading: The board will ask the PC to restore this as a permitted use

District Standards:

All are the same except we notice a type of "Minimum coverage" should be maximum coverage.

Supplemental District Standards:

1(a). state "no new structures, roads or driveways shall be placed....."

(b) Within the 50' lake shoreland protection area, the first 10' within the shoreland protection area shall be designated and maintained as a natural buffer zone (excluding the use of grass) .....10' will be a no mow zone .....; seek clarification if this pertains to existing, mowed lawns.

(e) Board will ask for "Except for purposes of erosion control riprap and retaining walls are not permitted....."

Proposed 3 (a):

Removal of a minimum amount of trees and vegetation is permitted consistent with development of the structure; safety; access to and use of the water and views of the lake.

A back up option:

This shall not reduce the shaded areas of the lake by \_\_\_\_%.

(b) Access paths through lake shoreland protection areas constructed so as to prevent erosion, avoid soil disturbance and disperse runoff away from the lake. This can include removal of the minimum amount of vegetation necessary to accommodate access that meets Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. The construction shall not involve earth moving equipment; stumps and roots must remain using the minimum amount of fill to allow for smooth passage.
